RE: Spending Period Extensions for Phases 39, ARPAR and 40

This message is to share that the National Board for the Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP) voted to offer additional spending period end dates beyond those offered initially when the Local Board Plans for Phases 39, ARPAR and 40 were made available to Local Boards. Local Boards may choose to extend their jurisdictions' spending periods to allow more time for Local Recipient Organizations (LROs) to provide food and shelter services to individuals and families. If Local Boards have not submitted their Board Plans for Phases 39, ARPAR and 40, the additional spending period options are now available for selection when the Board Plans are processed for submission to the National Board via the EFSP website. If Local Boards have successfully submitted their Board Plans but wish to change the spending end date for a jurisdiction, they may select the **Phase End Date Extension Request Form** on the EFSP website, which can be found after logging in with their user ID and password. Remember that the spending period selected by the Local Board will apply to each phase in which a jurisdiction is funded and all agencies in the jurisdiction.

The additional spending period end dates that Local Boards may select are listed below.
